

## Flowerpot Painting Tutorial





**Materials:**

Pencil

Eraser

Tape

Scissors

Acrylic paint markers

Paint brush

Cordage (rope/string/rubberband)

Variety of acrylic craft paints

Flowerpot



### **Step 1:**

Achieving straight lines across angled cylinders.

Using a piece of rope or cordage, wrap around your flowerpot, tape it down, and adjust it to create two straight, level lines across the surface. Then, trace the line lightly with a pencil.



**Step 2:**  
Stencil pattern

Create a small wave pattern on paper and cut it out. Use this shape to repeat trace along the bottom pencil line that you made on your flowerpot.





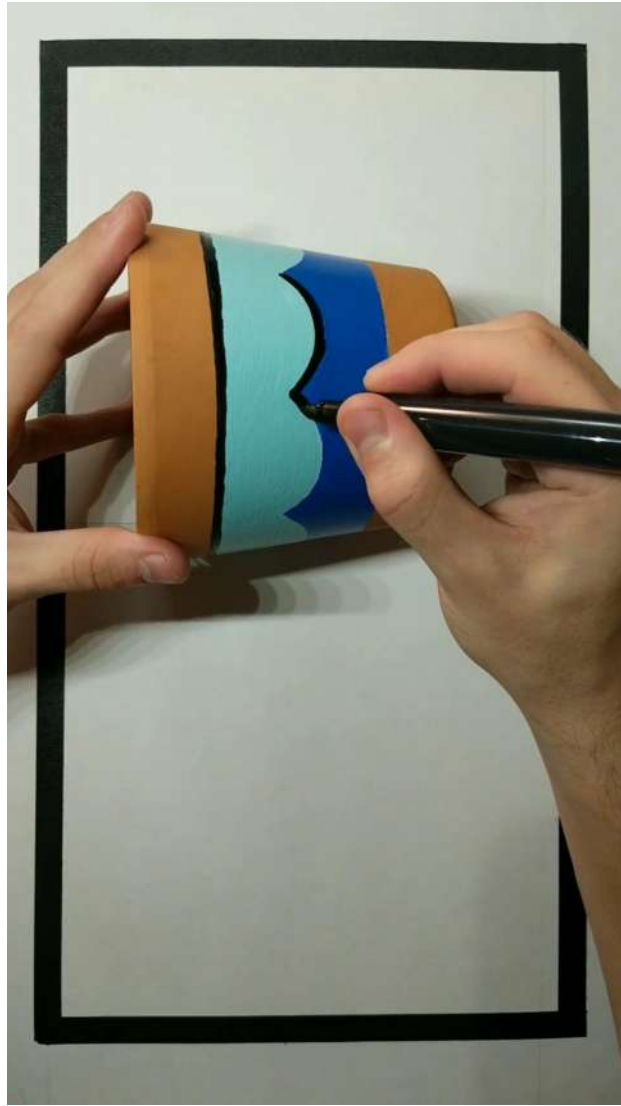
**Step 3:**  
White background

Paint a white background over your design area. This will ensure that your color paints are bright and accurate.



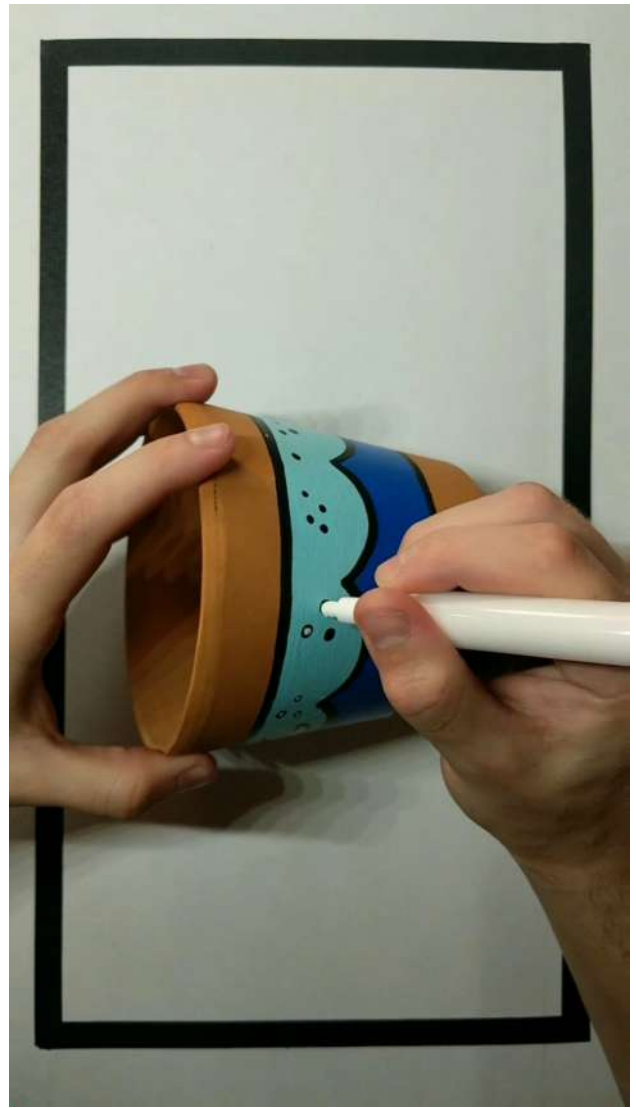
**Step 4:**  
Apply color

Brush two different colors onto the top and bottom half of your design area. I used dark blue for the ocean and light blue for the sky. Cover the entire white background, and add a second coat if needed.



**Step 5:**  
Outline

Using a black paint marker, outline along the separations of color for a pop illustrated effect.



**Step 6:**  
Illustrated details

Personalize the different sections of your flowerpot. You can add elements to the sky like planets, stars, clouds, or boats and fish to the water. It's entirely up to you! Add additional color highlights to make it pop.





**Step 7:**  
Let it grow!

Leave a special message for your future plant baby at the bottom of the flowerpot. Add seeds and soil, and help it grow!
